Angel Food Ministries

Is Here @ WCC

Wilmington Church of Christ has been authorized to be the host site for Angel Food Ministries in this area with Pete Little serving as the director. Angel Food Ministries is a non-profit, non-denominational organization dedicated to providing food relief to communities. The cornerstone of the ministry is to offer a hand up and not a hand out as a way to give to others. The food program was founded by Joseph and Linda Wingo while they were serving a church in Monroe, Georgia.

The regular box can be purchased for \$30. Depending on local food prices, the regular box retails between \$45 to \$75 with an average value of approximately \$60. The regular box assists in feeding a family of four for about one week, or a single person for almost a month.

A purchase table located in the Lobby will be open to process orders each Saturday from 9:00 to 11:00 AM and each Wednesday from 5:00 to 7:00 PM. All orders are paid with cash or food stamps. Orders can only be processed during these specific times or you may go online at angelfoodministries.org at site number 10579 and place your order there. Order Pickup Day in May is Saturday, May 16.

We're excited about this new outreach to our church and community. This ministry is a great way for WCC to put our hearts in action and make a difference in the lives of others during these difficult economic times. There is no better time to get involved!

River Rafting Trip September 17-19, Upper Gauley River, West Virginia Leader: Steve Wetterhan



An extreme rafting experience is being planned September 17-19 on the Upper Gauley River in West Virginia. The Gauley River is recognized as one of the top ranked rivers in the world. This is not a rafting trip for the faint of heart. All participants must be 16 years of age. The trip package is \$149.24 per person. The cost includes the rafting ticket, two nights lodging in cabins (Thursday and Friday night), and hot breakfast and steak dinner on Friday. There will be an additional charge if a church vehicle is used for transportation (\$10 per person).

The group will meet at 1:00 PM on Thursday, September 17 in the WCC parking lot to travel to River Expeditions camp ground near Fayetteville, WV.
