An extreme rafting experience is being planned September 17-19 on the Upper Gauley River in West Virginia. The Gauley River is recognized as one of the top ranked rivers in the world. Angel Food Ministries Is Here @ WCC

Wilmington Church of Christ has been authorized to be the host site for Angel Food Ministries in this area with Pete Little serving as the director. Angel Food Ministries is a non-profit, non-denominational organization dedicated to providing food relief to communities. The cornerstone of the ministry is to offer a hand up and not a hand out as a way to give to others. The food program was founded by Joseph and Linda Wingo while they were serving a church in Monroe, Georgia.

The regular box can be purchased for \$30. Depending on local food prices, the regular box retails between \$45 to \$75 with an average value of approximately \$60. The regular box assists in feeding a family of four for about one week, or a single person for almost a month.

A purchase table located in the WCC Lobby will open to process orders on Wednesday 5/27, 6/3 and 6/10 from 5:00 - 7:00 p.m. and Saturday 5/30, 6/6 and 6/13 from 9:00 to 11:00 a.m. All orders placed at WCC are paid with cash or food stamps. Orders can only be processed during these specific times or you may go online at angelfoodministries.org at site number 10579 and place your order there. Order Pickup Day in June is Saturday, June 20. Orders not picked up by 3:00 p.m. on June 20 will be donated.
