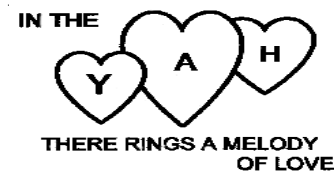

Maximum Impact Simulcast



The live leadership seminar hosted by WCC on Friday, May 15, proved to be a powerful and effective event. I want to thank personally Donnie Davis, Vance Hummelgard, and Gregg McGuire and others for organizing the simulcast. I also want to recognize the dedicated group of volunteers who served as hosts, greeters, receptionists, and cooks for the event. A total of 29 registrants and 5 volunteers took part in the simulcast. Over 50% of the registrants were not members or regular attendees at WCC. Registration fees and corporate sponsorships (Naylor's Furniture, Liberty Savings Bank, Smith-Feike-Minton Insurance, McGuire Coaching and Wilmington News Journal) underwrote 80% of the cost for the event.

The leadership seminar has attracted a total of 169 business leaders over the past 4 years. It has been determined that WCC will not host the event in 2010.
