Life Safety Sunday Lockdown Drill June 14, 2009

It took the ushers and greeters between five and ten minutes to notify the classes and secure the building. It is my opinion that this time frame is an excellent response period for the initial drill.

I want to express my gratitude to Pat Larrick and Dan Ellen for training their ministry volunteers and conducting the drill. I also want to thank Tim Miller and Bill Jenkins for their wise counsel regarding the lockdown procedure.

I would like to make you aware that all exterior doors to the building are scheduled to be secured and locked at 10:40 AM following the beginning of the worship service. I suggest if you arrive late for service, that you enter the building by means of the lobby or main entrance. Greeters will be posted at the lobby and main entrances to permit entry by those arriving late to service or needing reentry into the building after 10:40 AM.

A strategy is being developed to address security issues during Sunday and Wednesday evening activities. I will inform you about the new strategy before activities begin in September.
