



Thank you for your interest in the Sonshine Christian Preschool. We hope you will find this information helpful in your decision making process concerning your child's early childhood education.

The 2009-2010 school will begin the seventh year for the Sonshine Christian Preschool. We are a Christian Preschool. Our goal is to make the first educational experience for your child a positive one with a Christ-centered base. The children will enjoy chapel where they will learn interesting Bible stories, memory verses and fun songs that show God's love for them.

We will be using a blend of resources to introduce the children to the alphabet and their sounds. The children will learn colors, shapes, numbers, opposites, nursery rhymes and the senses. We will work on addresses, phone numbers and birthdays. During our center time, the teacher will have an opportunity to work individually with the children. This will enable them to achieve specific goals.

Large motor skills are exercised through recreation. Our inside play area is equipped with items for crawling, balancing, tumbling, throwing and catching to name a few. We will also work on hopping, skipping, jumping and walking backwards. The children will also have outside recreation as the weather permits. The outside recreation area is secured with a chain link fence that surrounds the entire space.

Small motor skills will be developed through writing and using scissors, working puzzles and other manipulatives. Emotional skills are explored through socialization with other children. We encourage independence and manners. The children will enjoy crafts, art and music. Each class will also have computer lab once a week. This will give the children a chance to learn to use computers.

Parents will transport their own child for our fall and spring field trip. We will host several special events and invite guest speakers. Parents will also be asked to provide a snack for their child's class on a regular basis. A monthly schedule will be provided. Special sign up sheets will be posted for parties. We are not a co-op; therefore parent participation is not required but always welcomed.
